

Stringed Instrument Rental Agreement from Main Street Music Lessons, LLC.

This agreement is between you, the renter, and Main Street Music Lessons, LLC. Teachers and schools are not responsible for any of the terms of this agreement. This agreement is in force for one year from the date below and is renewable at the discretion of Main Street Music Lessons, LLC or its successors. You can break the agreement by returning the instrument to Main Street Music Lessons. This agreement is not limited to the first instrument you rent. **Payment for the first two months is non-refundable. After initial rental meeting all future transactions will take place at Main Street Music Lessons. Do not send payments to your children's school. This is not a rent-to-own contract.**

As long as your account is paid up to date Main Street Music Lessons agrees to:

-Present a bill every month, which after the first two months, must be paid monthly.

Stringed Instruments Specific

-Supply you with a properly sized 'student' grade string outfit with student grade (or better) strings, a horsehair bow, a soft case for cellos and hard cases for violins & violas.

-Supply you with larger instruments as needed until full sized is reached.

-Within reason, repair or replace instruments, bows, or cases that have been damaged.

-Within reason, replace broken strings with student grade strings at our shop at no extra charge.

Wind Instruments Specific

-Supply you with an instrument appropriate for the student's level, a case to store the instrument, and non-consumable cleansing tools (flute rod, drop snake, etc.)

-Supply you with a starter reed, cleaning cloth, sax swab. Replacement of these items is the renter's responsibility

(Payments will not be prorated)

You agree to:

-Pay rental bills in a timely manner and protect the instrument from negligent damage. Rental fees are due and payable even if we fail to bill you. The due date of your payment is the day of the month this agreement is initiated beginning two months after initiation. If renting the instrument over the summer, payment must be made in advance (three months) before the end of the school year.

-Deliver the unwanted instrument to Main Street Music Lessons in Auburn when school is not in session for summer break. Fees will be charged until we have the instrument. This is not the orchestra teacher's responsibility.

-Not allow anyone other than Main Street Music Lessons to repair or modify the instrument.

If rental fees are not paid within 30 days of the due date:

-Main Street Music Lessons will no longer exchange instruments, repair damaged instruments or replace strings. Reasonable costs of servicing instruments and replacing parts will be added to the amount owed.

-Overdue accounts will incur an additional late fee of \$10.00 per month past due. After three months, past-due accounts will be placed for collection and credit reporting after notification.

-We will make every attempt to recover our instrument and the fees owed to us in a way consistent with current Maine and Federal laws.
